All federal contracts awarded after September 8, 2009 are subject to mandatory E-Verification requirements for certain employees and independent contractors. These recent regulations were designed to improve accuracy of wage and tax reporting and to guarantee a legal workforce on all federal projects. Failure to comply could result in suspension or debarment, adverse performance assessment and termination for default and damages.
