There she taught Math and English to high school students. Upon returning home, Tina entered federal service with the Social Security Administration. Tina started her Wage and Hour investigator career in 1980 in the Minneapolis District Office, where she worked for 4 years. She then worked in the Denver District Office. In 1996, Tina was selected to be the sole investigator in Alaska, reporting to the Seattle District Office. In Alaska, the work was nearly all government contract investigations. In 2002, Tina joined the field office in Tacoma, WA. Tina has served in a number of team coordinator roles, including child labor coordinator and criminal enforcement coordinator.
